Stewardship Special Giving for April North Lancaster Conference Disaster Response Team

Beth and Tom Smith will be in worship on Sunday, April 7, to offer a temple talk to provide us with details about this upcoming trip and the vital humanitarian work this team is up to. Please be present that day to hear from them; please consider giving generously to their efforts and those of the team of volunteers they represent.

Congregational Gatherings in April

New Bible Exploration

For those participating in the Bible study of Romans, remember there will not be class on Tuesday, March 26 (Holy Week) or Tuesday, April 2. We will resume the study on Tuesday, April 9 at 11:00 AM.

Continuing on Tuesdays you are invited to join in a study of the book of *Romans*. The study will take place each Tuesday morning from 11:00 AM to roughly 12:00 PM. "In his *Preface to Romans* Martin Luther writes, 'this epistle is really the chief part of the New Testament, and is truly the purest gospel...It is a bright light, almost sufficient to illuminate the entire Holy Scriptures'" (*Martin Luther's Basic Theological Writings*, second ed., Fortress, 2005 pp. 98-99). *Romans* is also the most challenging of the Pauline epistles and will likely provide those participating with significant, in-depth discussion and new ideas to chew on as we wade through it and learn and grow together in our faith lives and our relationships with God and our Lord.
