June Council Meeting Report

At the June 12 Congregation Council meeting, the Council:

- Approved the Finance Committee motion to donate \$7,000 for the Konde Diocese hospital construction and \$7,000 for capital projects at our synod's Lutheran Camping Corporation. This \$14,000 is from the tithe of the Esther Winters estate received earlier this year (\$4,000) and some of the accumulated investment earnings in our special benevolence fund (\$10,000).
- · Heard the Property Committee report that Requests for Proposals to update the elevator will be sent to contractors before the end of the month.
- · Received one bid to update and host our website. Other bids and recommendations are being sought.
- Received the Property Committee report that the "Top Hat" lights in the sanctuary have been replaced with new LED lights. Also, the storm drain in the parking lot needs repair.

Elevator Upgrade

For several months the Congregation Council has reported major upgrades are needed for our elevator. The Property Committee is seeking proposals and bids for the elevator upgrades. The plan is to have a special congregational meeting later this summer to discuss the recommendations received for the needed work. Council would not be surprised if the lowest bid is at least \$100,000. While some congregation reserve funds are available for this project, almost certainly a special appeal campaign will be needed. As soon as more information becomes available, it will be published and then explained at the special congregational meeting.

The John H. Moyer and Erma R. Moyer Scholarship Trust of The Evangelical Lutheran Church of the Holy Trinity has been established through a gift by their son, John R. Moyer, to honor his parents and perpetuate the family's belief in the importance of higher education.

The Trust provides for a one-year scholarship of \$1,000.00 to be awarded annually to an active member of Holy Trinity Lutheran Church. As the investment grows, the Finance Committee can recommend to the Congregational Council increasing the amount. The Finance Committee will notify the

Congregation Council in June each year of the amount available to be awarded so the Council can determine the number of scholarships that can be offered.

Applications and detailed Scholarship selection information can be obtained from the Church office. Completed applications and transcripts must be returned to the Church office no later than July 6.*** Please note this date change! Congregation Council will approve all applicable scholarship applications. Scholarship checks will be produced and presented to each approved applicant in September.
