



Altar Flowers and Worship Appointments-PLEASE READ

Beginning in 2023, the church will no longer be supplementing the cost of altar flowers for worship each week due to the increased cost of doing so. Our Ministry Support Plan, which was approved at the recent annual congregational meeting, does not allow for the added expense of weekly flowers. With the closing of Roxanne's Flowers at the end of December the church will once again be utilizing Royer's Flowers and Gifts for its floral needs. The cost for weekly altar flowers will be \$55.00. This amount will cover the cost of two vases and delivery. As in the past, please write your name on the flower chart in the Gathering Area for the Sunday(s) on which you wish to sponsor flowers and fill out one of the forms indicating who the flowers are to be giving "in honor of," "in memory of," or "in thanksgiving for," and turn that into the church office. Filling out a form will ensure the information to be included in the bulletin is accurate. In the same manner, if you wish to contribute toward weekly worship appointments, the bottom of the same form needs to be completed. The cost for weekly worship appointments can be for any amount. The flower chart is only for altar flowers. Please do not sign up for worship appointments on this chart. There will be no flowers on the altar on the Sundays when people have not sponsored flowers.

January Congregation Council Meeting

At its meeting January 12, the congregation council:

- Approved the Evangelism Committee request for \$125 licensing fee to show a movie February 5 that will be a community event.
- Requested that committee chairs submit a summary of committee meetings to be included in the *Messenger*.
- Directed the Property Committee to evaluate the current cleaning service provider and solicit additional proposals to provide the service.
- Affirmed that there will not be altar flowers for weeks there is no sponsor.



Change for Administrative Assistant

The Congregation Council has negotiated with Sue Johns, our administrative assistant, a reduction in work hours. For 2023, Sue will work 20 less days with a corresponding reduction in pay. This means that some weeks will work one less day (or perhaps ½ day). As always, check the *Messenger* for Sue's schedule for the following week. A reminder, if you plan to come to the building or office, it is a good practice to call first to make certain the building is open.

2022 Sweigart Foundation Grant

In response to our request, the Sweigart Foundation has again generously awarded a grant to Holy Trinity. The \$5,000 grant was made in December. The Congregation Council has made the following allocations of the grant:

- \$1,000 for Trini Mini supplies and programs
- \$1,200 for transportation of students to Trini Mini
- \$1,800 for a **2024** concert, perhaps by a Millersville University music organization
- \$1,000 for organ case and pipe repair

organ. The case holding pipes above the choir loft became loose over time and was in danger of falling. The case was more securely reattached and painted. At the same time, the exposed pipes were cleaned and repaired. The total cost of the repair done by Brunner & Associates was \$5,731.56. The cost was paid using \$1,000 of the Sweigart Foundation grant and \$4,731.56 from our Thanksgiving and Memorial Fund.
