Child Protection Policy Training

Our new church insurance policy requires that all persons of Holy Trinity Lutheran Church, staff and volunteers alike, who presently have a background check on file or wish to volunteer during 2024 must attend an annual child protection training at which the congregational Child Protection Policy is reviewed. To assist you in fulfilling this requirement there will be a training for all those to whom this applies on **Sunday**, **February 25 during the Adult Forum**. There will be sign-up sheet in the Gathering Area, so please include your name so we can make sure there are enough materials available for everyone attending the training.

Stewardship Special Giving for January Mountaineer's Table

We are excited to be adding *Mountaineer'sTable* to our list of organizations whose live-giving work we support as the people of God at Holy Trinity. *Mountaineer'sTable* (a 501c3 organization), formerly known as the *Ephrata Power Packs Project*, is in its 10th year of serving families in the Ephrata Area School District (EASD). In 2022 alone, they distributed over 135,000 lbs. of food, feeding an average of 75 families a week, and are presently serving 110 families per week with numbers of those facing daily food insecurity rising. There is no cost to EASD families, who each Thursday arrive at the Ephrata Church of the Brethren to collect their nutritious food, including fresh fruits and vegetables, and a recipe with the needed ingredients provided to prepare the meal. It is an all-volunteer organization, so all monies donated go directly to help the families get food on the table so that children are well fed and ready to learn.

Stephanie Weber, the director and visionary behind this organization, will be joining us in worship on Sunday, January 7 to further introduce us to the important work being done to assist our struggling neighbors. Please plan to be present at 9:00 AM worship to welcome her and learn more.

2023 Donation Statements

The 2023 Donation Statements were emailed to all members for whom we have email addresses. The statements are emailed one per household, to the primary email we have for that household. For those without email addresses, the printed statements are on the table in the Gathering Area. They will remain there through January 28. End of Year Financial Report

A sincere thank you to the members who made a contribution to the Special Appeal conducted in November and December.

39 Giving Units gave a total of \$25,453 to the Special Appeal.

The Special Appeal contributions enabled us to reduce the 2023 Unified Budget deficit to \$50,551.51. Reserve funds were used to erase the deficit.

Though we had some additional costs for the year (i.e. the total cost to purchase heating oil) the 2023 deficit was less than anticipated because we spent \$24,500 **less** than budgeted on three line items. The major savings were:

• \$12,277 less for insurance because we switched carriers

• \$9,600 less for cleaning services (we did not have a cleaning service for a number of months)

• \$2,900 less for secretary salary due to the reduced hours

There were 108 giving units in 2023, one additional giving unit than in 2022.

Congregation Council Report

At the January 11 meeting, the Congregation Council:

• President Christy Boos reported that a letter has been sent to our Lower Susquehanna Synod Bishop requesting guidance and assistance for the congregation as it plans the next steps due to the financial situation.

Asked the Property Committee to make arrangements for increased use of the gymnasium, especially for pickleball use.

Had a Zoom presentation from Partners for Sacred Spaces to explain how the organization could assist Holy Trinity planning for greater use of our building. The Council will make a decision about contracting with the organization at a future meeting.

• Planned an adult forum for Sunday, February 25, for all volunteers and staff working with children and other members who are interested in learning about the congregation's Child Protection Policy. This is a required forum by the Protection Policy the Council adopted in conjunction with our insurance provider.

Planned an adult forum for Sunday, April 14, to present and discuss the plan the Council will bring to the April 28 congregational meeting for the next steps for the future of Holy Trinity.

Approved a request from the Property Committee that the former cleaning service (which resigned in December because of scheduling conflicts) be retained to clean on an "as available" basis. The cleaning service contacted Holy Trinity and requested this arrangement. Volunteer teams will continue to clean the weeks the cleaning service is unavailable. The day of the week may vary for the provider to clean.
