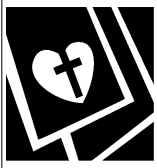

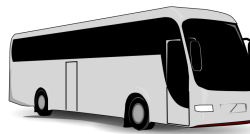

MOYER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The John H. Moyer and Erma A. Moyer Scholarship Trust of The Evangelical Lutheran Church of the Holy Trinity has been established through a gift by their son, John R. Moyer, to honor his parents and perpetuate the family's belief in the importance of higher education.

The Trust provides for a one-year scholarship of at least \$800, to be awarded annually to a member of Holy Trinity Lutheran Church who will be full-time, third year student, majoring in Elementary or Secondary Education, at a Pennsylvania college or university. August Stewardship Focus: Lancaster County Food Hub

Since 1947, the Lancaster County Food Hub (LCFH), formally the Lancaster County Council of Churches, has served the most needy and marginalized members of our society as well as the working poor struggling to make ends meet. The overarching goal of our organization is to help fill the gap for these individuals and families by providing services in four key areas. They are Food, Clothing, Shelter and Transportation.

The Hub has seen a significant rise in requests over the last few years, and in response to the increased demand purchased and renovated a 27,000 square foot warehouse in downtown Lancaster in 2014/2015.

Housed in this warehouse is a 7500 square foot **Food Hub** that serves as the largest food distribution site in Lancaster County. Last year over 31,000 people came to the Hub to receive food and the need continues to rise.

The Hub also operates the largest free **Clothing Bank** in our area as well as holds the contract to operate the **PA Workwear** program in Lancaster County. The PA Workwear Program works in conjunction with Career Link to provide interview appropriate attire for individuals preparing for a job interview. After they have secured employment, they receive a week's worth of work clothing as well as proper footwear if needed such as steel toed boots, nurse's shoes and non-skid shoes. The clothing bank is open to anyone and is available for individuals to come every 60 days. Additionally, the Hub has a fully stocked **Hygiene Bank** which provides all toiletry items as well as laundry detergent for clients once a month.

The **Wheels to Work** is a Workforce Development program to assist people who are entering the workforce with their own vehicle. Research has shown that the single strongest barrier in the attempt to escape poverty and build a better life is the lack of reliable transportation. Through the Wheels to Work program, applicants are able to purchase their own vehicle at 75% of the fair market value. All vehicles in the program have undergone a diagnostic screening, fixed of any needed repairs and inspected prior to being sold.

From December to April, The Hub operates **Winter Shelter** for homeless women and homeless mothers and their children. This emergency overflow shelter provides a warm and safe place for the women to sleep where they can receive all the basic necessities of toiletries, bedding, towels, blankets, and snacks as well as emergency case management to help move them into permanent housing. This program can house up to 44 women and children per night.

Stewardship Special Giving for JULY: Milagro House

Our Mission: Milagro House provides education, housing and support services for women and their children who would otherwise be experiencing homelessness. Our vision is to prepare the women and children who come through our doors with the skills they need to break the cycle of homelessness and poverty and move from dependence to self-sufficiency. What sets Milagro House apart in our industry is the educational component to the program. Education is the underpinning of everything we do at Milagro House and is the catalyst for women moving from dependence to independence through meaningful employment at a self-sustaining wage.

Services Provided:

Educational Services

Women accepted into our program must be committed to pursuing educational advancement. The staff at Milagro House customizes each woman's program to meet her specific needs and interests. Milagro House offers two educational options for women in our program
GED Program: Provides GED classes conducted by a certified teacher and volunteer tutors. Post-Secondary Programs: Works with staff to develop a post-secondary education plan and attend college and certification programs of their choice.

Residential and Support Services

Provides support through – Housing for women and children customized case management, individual and group counseling, parenting programs, life skills training, children's programs.

After Milagro House

After education, gaining employment and housing, case management staff continue to work with the families for their first year to help ensure their continued success. For additional information check their website at www.Milagrohous.org

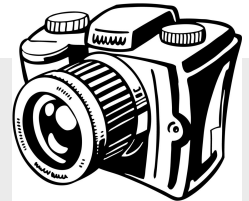

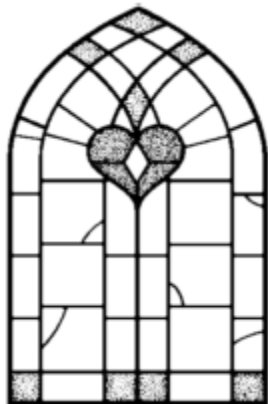
